Description

Ramses II in Paris. Bronze commemorative medal of the Pharaoh's visit for an Egyptian exhibition in 1976-1977 at the Musée de l'Homme. By Belmondo, 1978. More than 3,200 years after the death of Ramses II in Paris, a scientific symposium was convened to save the remains of the deceased pharaoh, as well as his sarcophagus, which were infested with fungi and parasites. Numerous analyses made it possible to reconstruct his life, pathologies, surface and internal anatomy, and to save the mummy through massive irradiation. A rare souvenir medal, almost impossible to find today. Diameter: 67 mm
