Adorable solid silver doll's cutlery set. The scalloped spatulas are decorated with putti raising their arms. They surmount a water leaf motif. Each piece is hallmarked: 800 for the standard silver content, Crown and crescent for German solid silver. A barely legible hallmark, to be identified. Probably the maker's mark. Weevil hallmark in an oval for imported pieces, used for silver between 1864 and 1893. Charming little miniature cutlery set, rare in solid silver with this rich rocaille decoration. 7.8 to 9.8 cm long, 19.8 grams. Very good condition. Minor scratches from use.
