A pair of painted stone plaques depicting the Virgin and Child in Glory, surrounded by kneeling angels and saints, and the Vision of Saint John the Evangelist, writing his Gospel, accompanied by his eagle, before a celestial apparition of the Virgin on the island of Patmos. Italian work from the late 16th or early 17th century. These plaques likely came from a small altarpiece. Sold as is, with visible old restorations and repairs.
