The piece has a slender and balanced silhouette, enhanced by a carved dark wood handle, offering a warm contrast to the satin sheen of the silver. The craftsmanship is of high quality, characteristic of 20th-century Dutch silversmithing, with meticulous handwork and a decidedly modernist aesthetic. The Schönhoven hallmark attests to controlled Dutch manufacture and 934/1000 silver, a high standard specific to the Netherlands.
