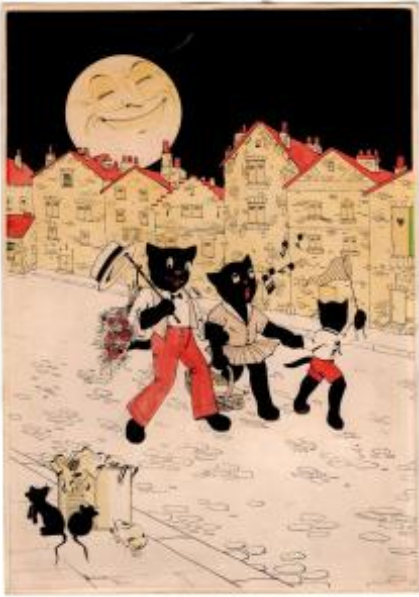




The Cat Family

Description: A pair of charming original illustrations for the press or children's publishing, depicting a family of cats portrayed as humans and acting like humans, staged in an urban setting. The scenes take place at night, on a street lined with red-roofed houses, under a stylized moon that adds a poetic and humorous touch. The cats, dressed in period costumes, are shown in motion in situations evoking everyday life. The drawing, executed in ink and enhanced with watercolor, displays a fluid and expressive line, characteristic of illustration from the late 1920s. The deliberately limited palette plays on the contrasts between blacks, reds, and light tones, ensuring good legibility. Condition: Very good
