Description

Important pair of three-light wall sconces in finely chased gilt bronze - Louis XVI style - Napoleon III period (circa 1870). This "Greek-style" model is distinguished by its fluted quiver-shaped stem surmounted by a vigorously sculpted ram's head, an emblematic motif of the Neoclassical repertoire. The whole is crowned by a floral bouquet finial, while the base terminates in a delicate chased pine cone. The precision of the decoration extends to the spiraling of the light arms, whose elegant movement ensures a harmonious diffusion of light. The quality of the chasing is particularly remarkable, notably on the cascading beaded garlands and the sockets adorned with acanthus leaves. The original gilding is superb, displaying a beautiful alternation of matte and polished finishes that
