Comma-shaped earrings, reminiscent of a paisley pattern, in 18k yellow gold (750/°°, eagle's head hallmark), adorned with crown-cut rose diamonds set on a richly granulated base. This textural work gives the earrings a matte finish while adding brilliance to the grain, highlighting the subtle and delicate sparkle of the rose-cut diamonds. Their design, craftsmanship, and the rose cut of the diamonds transport us to this Indonesian region, a crossroads of cultures and influences. Their asymmetrical shape allows them to be worn in any direction, as desired, or simply to follow the shape of the ear. Both understated and richly crafted, these distinctive earrings are suitable for any occasion. They shimmer softly in daylight and shine with incomparable brilliance under artificial light. The fastening system consists of a

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post (for pierced ears) combined with an alpa clasp. Two distinct notches on the stem ensure both a perfect fit and security.
