Dimensions: Sight size: 14 x 13.5 cm Framed (some losses): 37 x 32 cm Alexandre Fridzeri (Verona 1741 - Antwerp 1825) was an Italian composer and musician. He was a virtuoso of the mandolin, as well as a violinist and organist. Having lost his sight at a very young age, this did not prevent him from continuing his career. Fridzeri is considered a talented and appreciated artist of his time for his varied compositions (operas, chamber music, instrumental pieces), despite a life marked by adversity due to his disability and historical events.
