### Description

A sculptural travertine coffee table from France, dating to the 1980s, shaped with the quiet monumentality and refined minimalism that defined late-mid-century European design. Its monolithic silhouette, composed of a thick rectangular top resting on a solid block base, celebrates the natural beauty of travertine while embracing the clean architectural lines that became emblematic of the period. The travertine displays warm, sandy tones with subtle veining and characteristic pores, giving the table an organic depth that contrasts beautifully with its geometric form. The softly rounded edges of the top add a tactile softness to the otherwise bold structure, while the matte finish enhances the stone's natural texture. Each surface reveals the unique stratification of the material, making the

table both a functional object and a geological artwork. Although created in the 1980s, the table draws directly from mid-century modern principles: purity of form, honesty of materials, and a focus on sculptural simplicity. This table embodies that ethos; minimalist yet expressive, modern yet deeply connected to natural materiality.
