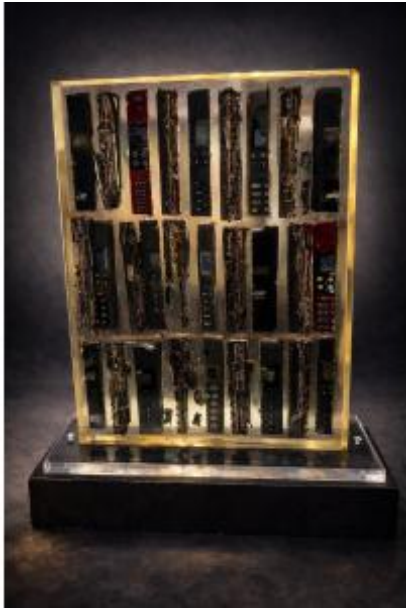

Arman (1928-2005) Accumulation - GSM
Numbered 28/30, signed. A work in transparent resin containing an accumulation of mobile phones (GSM), arranged vertically and frozen in the material. The whole rests on a black base. This piece perfectly illustrates Arman's work, famous for his "accumulations," in which he assembles and repeats everyday objects. Here, the mobile phone becomes a symbol of our modern society and technological evolution. The transparency of the resin highlights the shapes, circuits, and internal details of the devices, creating a strong and contemporary visual effect. This is a limited edition of 30 copies in Roman numerals, dating from the 2000s corresponding to the first printings, rarer and more sought after than the larger editions of 100 (in Arabic
