The Boulenger firm, active throughout the 19th century and particularly renowned between 1876 and 1899 under Adolphe Boulenger, is celebrated for the quality of its silverwork and its decorative elegance. The piece is harmonious, both decorative and functional: a powder box, jewelry box, candy box, or small toiletry kit. Period: 19th century. Mount: Solid silver, by the silversmith Boulenger.
