### Description

An Exceptional Late 18th-century Georgian Elm Country Carver Armchair, circa 1790. This handsome country chair is crafted from solid elm and features a shaped top rail, three splat and ball back, and swept open arms with scrolling terminals and turned supports. The solid plank seat, with a height of 43cm, is raised on square legs joined by stretchers to all four sides, ensuring strength and stability. Of particular note is the traditional pegged construction: the frame is made using mortise and tenon joints secured with pegs, exactly as expected of fine Georgian craftsmanship. The elm has developed a rich, warm and mellow patina over more than three centuries of careful use and polishing, giving the piece real depth of character. Professionally cleaned and waxed in our workshops, this
