### Description

A glazed stoneware money box depicting a grotesque male head in high relief, with a grimacing expression and a wide-open mouth forming the coin slot. The piece displays expressive modeling: a furrowed brow, half-closed eyes, a powerful nose, and a mustache and beard rendered in thick, tormented masses. The entire piece is covered with a poured glaze in nuanced shades of brown, honey, and olive green, with effects of withdrawal and drips reminiscent of late 19th-century ceramic techniques. The body, cylindrical in shape and slightly truncated at the top, is partially left in bare stoneware at the bottom, contrasting with the glazed upper section. A work from the early 20th century, in the style of the sculptor Jean Carries and the Symbolist movement. A striking decorative piece, this unique
