Description

A charming 19th-century miniature, presented in an oval silver mount in the 17th-century style, surmounted by a crown and fitted with its hanging ring. It depicts the portrait of Albert VII, Archduke of Austria, in a highly decorative historical portrait style. A beautiful collector's item, both intimate and a "state portrait" due to its subject and crowned mount. A discreetly refined display piece: the 17th-century-inspired silver mount enhances the miniature with its architectural silhouette (the crown at the top) and a slightly domed glass that accentuates the effect of depth. The choice of a portrait of Albert VII reflects the 19th-century taste for history, dynasty, and princely effigies, often revisited in miniatures intended for cabinets and collections. In the tradition of 19th-century historicist

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miniatures, the subject matter is aristocratic and dynastic, with mounts inspired by the 17th and 18th centuries, often designed to be worn, hung, or kept in a cabinet.
