Charming Late 17th-Century Oak Lowboy Side Table with Great Patina
A delightful late 17th-century oak lowboy side table, circa 1680, of small, elegant proportions and with a superb rich color and patina. The table features a solid two plank oak top with beautiful grain with a generous overhang and depth of tone, above a single molded working drawer. The drawer front is fitted with original period solid carved brass drop handles. Standing on finely turned bulbous legs, united by the original stretchers and terminating in turned feet, this piece retains its original top, rear backboard, legs and stretchers. The frame is traditionally made using mortise and tenon joints secured with pegs, as you would expect of the period. The oak has developed a wonderfully warm, mellow surface from over
