Gérard Leclerc: Between Post-Impressionism and Realism. Gérard Leclerc's stylistic journey is defined by a constant search for vibrant color. A painter of Mediterranean light, although he has explored various subjects, his name is inextricably linked to Provence and the French Riviera. His career is that of an artist who is a "traveler of light." He specializes in capturing the striking contrasts of the South of France: the narrow streets of Hyères, Bormes-les-Mimosas, and Saint-Tropez, as well as the small fishing ports and landscapes of the Var hinterland. He favors plunging perspectives and close-ups of old facades, which lends his works an intimate and warm quality. Gérard Leclerc belongs to that category of artists of regional talent with national reach. He is an artist who occupies an important place in 20th-century landscape painting, particularly appreciated for his depictions of the South of France. He exhibited in numerous salons and galleries in the South of France, where he built a loyal clientele of collectors devoted to Provençal heritage.
