The birds, with their outstretched wings, appear to emerge from the vegetal composition, creating a powerful and decorative relief. The polychromy and silver highlights emphasize the modeling of the carving and provide a beautiful contrast to the dark velvet background, which particularly highlights the richness of the relief. This decorative ensemble evokes the grand Louis XVI and Louis XVI Revisited styles, highly prized in early
