Description

Little Girl with a Kitten, After Jean-Baptiste Perronneau. A delightful 19th-century oval miniature, presented in an elegant silver frame adorned with marcasites, the back in tortoiseshell with a mother-of-pearl fleur-de-lis inlaid with mother-of-pearl. The mount is surmounted by a Louis XVI-style ribbon, also set with marcasites. The miniature (after Jean-Baptiste Perronneau) features eight fleurs-de-lis on the reverse, and the whole is fitted with a hanging ring (ready to wear/hang). A beautiful display piece and sentimental jewel, typical of the 19th-century historicist taste for miniatures "in the style of...". The silver mount with marcasites elegantly frames the scene, while the Louis XVI ribbon adds a touch of neoclassical refinement. The whole combines the intimate charm of the

miniature with the preciousness of a jewelry setting. In the tradition of collectible miniatures and portraits "after" the masters so prized in the 19th century, often inspired by 18th-century artists (Perronneau, Greuze, Vigée Le Brun, etc.), mounted as jewelry or pendant frames. European work, 19th century. Painted miniature. Silver and marcasite frame. Overall dimensions: height 10.2 cm; width 7.2 cm. Visible dimensions (miniature): height 8.3 cm; width 6.6 cm. Good overall condition, see photos. Note: a few marcasite stones are missing from the Louis XVI ribbon (3 missing). The rest is well preserved, the mount is stable, the decorative reverse is intact, and the ring is present.
