Description

A graceful expression of early 20th-century French design, this 1915 Art Nouveau side table unites the warmth of walnut with the cool refinement of marble in a form that feels both sculptural and intimate. Its silhouette, gently tapering and subtly organic, reflects the movement's devotion to nature-inspired lines and the belief that functional objects should also carry an artistic presence. The walnut frame is shaped with the fluidity characteristic of the Art Nouveau period, its curves soft and continuous, as though grown rather than constructed. Carved details at the ends of the top frame introduce a touch of botanical ornament, enhancing the table's sense of movement without overwhelming its clarity. The wood has developed a mellow, glowing patina over more than a century, deepening the contrast

between the carved motifs and the smooth expanses of grain. Set within the wooden surround, the marble top adds a refined counterpoint. Its veining introduces a natural pattern that harmonizes with the table's organic lines, while its polished surface brings a quiet luminosity. Below, a lower shelf mirrors the top's elegant shape, creating a balanced composition and offering additional display space.
