Attributable to Northern France, this trompe-l'oeil terrine, its base and lid in fine earthenware, depicts a cauliflower with a naturalistic decoration composed of two tall rows of green leaves and a beige center. The base is molded with similar green leaves, and the handle is shaped like garlic. 19th century. Some wear. This cauliflower was featured in an exhibition in 1985, the booklet for which is included with the piece.
