These highly prized swords or steel would have been taken during their conquest of the Franks The sword itself is in excellent condition and is sturdy and secure, the blade with its double fuller shows the age and trauma of multible battles, from the surface to the edges of the sword. The guard also displays many scars as you would expect. The handle is likley a later addition but not modern. The blade also has the
