### Description

An elegant decorative textile, likely Ottoman, embroidered entirely with silver metallic threads forming a rich calligraphic design. The stylized Arabic calligraphic decoration is ornamental in nature. The composition is organized around a wide border of stylized Arabic script, executed in dense embroidery, framing a central panel adorned with vegetal and symbolic motifs. These include a crescent moon accompanied by a stylized star, decorative elements frequently associated with Ottoman ornamental art. The embroidery, worked with silver metallic thread, creates a refined relief and delicately captures the light. The piece showcases exquisite craftsmanship, demonstrating the textile expertise of Near Eastern workshops. This textile could have been used as a tablecloth, chest of drawers
