Georges Scott (1873-1943) - Young Girl with Toys, Watercolor Drawing, 1909. Charming watercolor drawing signed, dated, and dedicated to "Sophie" in 1909 by Georges Scott, a French artist renowned for the finesse of his line and the sensitivity of his compositions. The work depicts a young girl wearing an elegant hooded coat, delicately holding a few children's toys, a scene imbued with sweetness and poetry. The drawing is distinguished by the delicacy of the line and by subtle watercolor coloring, in soft and harmonious tones that highlight the delicate expression of the figure and the rendering of the fabrics. Georges Scott, a very active illustrator and painter at the turn of the 20th century, is particularly known for his collaborations with the illustrated press and for the narrative quality of
