The embossed decoration lends the screen a rich ornamentation typical of the 19th-century historicist taste for Spanish and Moorish decorative arts. The reverse side is lined with studded natural leather, forming rectangular panels highlighted with upholstery tacks, attesting to meticulous craftsmanship. The panels are hinged with metal hinges, allowing for adjustable arrangement. The gently curved top edge accentuates the screen's elegant silhouette.
