The AV Mazzega workshop, founded by Angelo Vittorio Mazzega in Murano in the 1940s, became one of the great names of Italian lighting in the 1960s. The 1960s mark a new beginning for both Murano which no longer produces only classical chandeliers inspired by traditional Venetian baroque: designers reinvent blown glass, shapes become more sculptural, stainless steel & chrome appear and blend with glass. Witness to this meeting between ancestral Venetian craftsmanship and futuristic design, this iconic wall lamp by Mazzega & Murano is still today highly modernly retro and futuristic, chrome and opaline with its amber tip inspired by the conquest of space in the 60s, who have greatly influenced the interior
