The whole is joined by a concave stretcher. Its frieze is adorned with a rich, finely chased gilt bronze mount decorated with laurel wreaths and ribbons. Beautiful wood, lovely patina. A Parisian piece of exceptionally high-quality craftsmanship, with refined and elegant lines, in the style of Jacob's production.
