Framed miniature gouache on ivory, signed HIL, of Louis XVII, late 19th century. A true collector's item, this marvelous gouache, signed "HIL," is a 19th-century reproduction of the portrait of Louis-Charles de France, Dauphin of France, son of Louis XVI and Queen Marie Antoinette of Austria. A prince with a tragic destiny, the French Revolution did not spare the young prince, who died in captivity in the Temple prison. This portrait, the most famous, reflects the taste of the late 19th century, when miniatures and reproductions of classical and museum paintings were fashionable. Signed by the artist HIL, little is known about this artist, apart from his reproductions of classical works, faithful to the originals and of high quality.
