The Anfibio three-seater sofa, designed by Alessandro Becchi in the late 1960s and produced by Giovannetti in Italy, is fully upholstered in cognac-colored full-grain leather and distinguished by its soft, enveloping volumes. Rounded shapes, visible stitching, and snap-button side straps are characteristic design elements. The integrated convertible system allows the seat to be unfolded into a bed, making the Anfibio a sofa that is as functional as it is sculptural. An iconic piece of 1970s Italian design, it embodies a radical approach to comfort, prioritizing fluid forms and a strong organic presence in the space. Produced by Giovannetti, Italy, circa 1970.
