Description

Creation of the Breton ceramic artist André L'Helguen (1935-2017), this glazed stoneware vase imitates the shape of a pitcher. Its enamel and painted decoration are typical of the productions of the ceramist workshops of Keraluc in Quimper in the 60s, where color was back in vogue, and raw forms were appreciated or even privileged. We notice a taste for decoration, and the desire to make utilitarian design artistic & decorative, with a summer polychromy between blue, yellow, and cream. True decorative force, this decorative trompe l'oeil is a real gem of French craftsmanship and more precisely Breton, always prized by collectors and lovers of ceramics from the mid-20th century, this vase
