This 17th-century Aragonese cabinet stands as a bold and refined precursor to modern minimalism, where the purity of its geometric lines anticipates the "less is more" aesthetic by several centuries. It is a paradigmatic example of the beauty of simple forms; its façade, organized by a rigorous grid of drawers and doors, dispenses with superfluous ornamentation, relying entirely on the proportion and balance of its volumes for its visual impact. The excellence of this piece lies fundamentally in the nobility of its materials. Entirely carved from walnut, the cabinet displays a striking simplicity where the natural grain of the wood constitutes the sole and sophisticated decorative element. The robustness of the Aragonese walnut, combined with impeccable craftsmanship, transforms this cabinet
