Art Nouveau bust of a young woman, titled "Mignon," signed P. Mengin for Paul Eugène Mengin, 1853-1937. Metal bust with a silver patina. This piece also bears the Susse Frères foundry mark. Made in 1894, numbered 5 underneath. Paul-Eugène Mengin (1853-1937) Mengin was a highly renowned artist whose bronze and terracotta works are true collector's items. He studied under the sculptors Aimé Millet and Auguste Dumont at the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris. He exhibited regularly at the Salon des Artistes Français from 1873 onwards and won numerous medals (Bronze Medal at the 1900 Universal Exhibition). He was a master of elegant realism. He is particularly famous for his busts of prominent figures (such as Claude Bernard and Sarah Bernhardt) and his exquisitely detailed
