Description

A striking embodiment of 1930s Art Deco elegance, this sculptural armchair blends bold geometry with tactile richness. Upholstered in a sumptuous green velvet across the seat and backrest, the chair's inner surfaces invite comfort and visual depth, while the outer shell--rendered in warm brown leatherette--adds a sleek, architectural contrast. The interplay of textures is both deliberate and dramatic, reflecting the movement's fascination with material juxtaposition and modern luxury. The silhouette is compact yet assertive, with gently flared arms and a squared back that echo the streamlined forms of early modernist design. Brass nailhead trim traces the contours with precision, adding a touch of metallic glamor and framing the upholstery like a tailored garment. The wooden
