A child on the back in a traditional baby carrier. The sculpture exudes an impression of warmth and serenity: both figures have very expressive and smiling faces, characteristic of the fuzoku-ga (scenes of daily life) style. It was created with great attention to detail, as evidenced by the expressive faces and faithfully reproduced details, such as hairstyles and clothing. Japan, Meiji era (1868-1912), signed: ??? (Kakuha-sei). Kakuha Kanzaemon IX (?????), whose real name was Kakuha Zenjiro (?????), was a member of a family of artists from Toyama. In 1869, he opened a branch in the port of Yokohama, which handled the export of bronze products and retail sales to foreign clients in Japan. Height 33.5 cm, width 16 cm, depth 15 cm.
