Description

An elegant solid oak stool crafted in the spirit of the Arts & Crafts movement, dating from the early 20th century, circa 1900-1920. The frame is entirely made of solid oak, with a beautiful warm patina and pronounced grain. The base consists of two wide, carved panels decorated with softened arches, typical of the Arts & Crafts decorative vocabulary, which emphasizes simplicity of form and highlights the material. A central stretcher ensures the stability of the whole. A lateral wooden wedge system is also a noteworthy detail of handcrafted construction, demonstrating traditional joinery. The rectangular seat has a slight overhang with softened corners. The overall effect is a simple yet robust silhouette, characteristic of furniture influenced by the ideas of William Morris and the Arts & Crafts
