Description

This chandelier was made in France in the 1920s. Its gilt metal frame has a beautiful, warm patina. The design is richly ornamented, with metal scrolls rising to the top chain. The arms flare into elegant loops, creating a balanced and symmetrical form. Twelve candle-style lights, with cream-colored cylindrical sleeves reminiscent of traditional wax candles, are set in shallow, clear glass dishes, adding a touch of sparkle and refinement. Numerous crystal embellishments adorn the piece. Large, faceted, teardrop-shaped pendants hang from the arms and center, along with large, scalloped crystal drops. Garlands of tiny crystal beads form festoons between the arms, accentuating the chandelier's luxurious and romantic appearance. Small flowers decorate the joints, reinforcing the floral
