Japanese police officer's saber with its steel scabbard and an attractive shagreen hilt, model 1870-1945. Marked on the tang in Japanese characters: Manchurian Cavalry (see photo). Number 11057 on the blade and scabbard. Shagreen hilt decorated in bronze with cherry blossoms and two crossed flags (police insignia). Dimensions: 90 cm overall. This Japanese Imperial Police officer's saber, used during World War II, is an impressive example of the technology and finesse of Japanese edged weapons. This saber, distinguished by its steel, single edge, and curved shape, is a testament to Japanese hammered craftsmanship. It features a steel and shagreen hilt with a screw at the top of the pommel, which differs from traditional models such as the katana or kyu-gunto. This
