### Description

A powerful Post-Impressionist painting from the 1920s-1930s depicting a monastery refectory with monks at mealtimes... The work is signed "Jean Lair," which corresponds to Jean Lair de la Haye (1889-1964), an excellent artist whose work can be found online. A native of Marseille, he was a renowned and respected artist who received official commissions such as the paintings for the grand staircase of the Marseille Courthouse, the immense panel in Parc Chanot, and finally, he created a triptych of the Virgin Mary for the church in Plan-de-Cuques... It is worth noting that the Louvre Museum owns one of his works entitled "Rue de Mellah à Mogador"... Note: the work offered here is interesting because the colors are distributed with a generosity that reflects the influence of Adolphe Monticelli
