Description

This elegant blue and white porcelain vase features a refined decorative scheme inspired by traditional East Asian ceramic design. The surface is entirely adorned with a repeating lattice pattern composed of stylized floral buds connected by softly curved cobalt lines, creating a rhythmic and harmonious motif across the entire body of the piece. The decoration is executed in underglaze cobalt blue on a luminous white porcelain ground, a classic combination long associated with Asian ceramic traditions. The vase presents a graceful silhouette with a gently rounded body rising toward a slender neck and a softly flared rim. This balanced form allows the continuous pattern to flow seamlessly from base to lip, enhancing the visual elegance of the piece. The interior is glazed in a soft creamy white,

while the unmarked base reveals the fine porcelain body. Based on its decoration, glaze, and construction, this vase was most likely produced in the mid- to late 20th century, drawing inspiration from traditional Chinese blue-and-white porcelain motifs. Such pieces were commonly created as decorative ceramics for export markets or for interior decoration, often produced in Asian porcelain workshops influenced by classical Chinese aesthetics. The hand-painted appearance of the cobalt decoration, with subtle variations in tone and brushwork, gives the design depth and character. Both decorative and versatile, this vase works beautifully as a standalone object or as a vessel for flowers, bringing a timeless blue-and-white elegance to any interior setting.
