Description

The Louis XVI period, characterized by a return to classical purity and a departure from Rococo exuberance, favored symmetry, precise ornamentation, and the celebration of ancient Greek and Roman motifs. The Distinguished Dial and the Master Clockmaker: The large white enamel dial features Roman numerals for the hours and Arabic numerals for the minutes, a hallmark of high-quality 18th-century dials, combining clarity with

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aesthetic appeal. The dial proudly bears the signature of CAUSARD DUROY, attesting to its creation by a prominent and highly respected French clockmaker of the period. This distinctive design is notably attributed to the renowned French cabinetmaker, Robert Osmond, a master celebrated for his exquisite bronze mounts and creations during the reigns of Louis XV and Louis XVI. His involvement underscores the exceptional quality and artistic provenance of this piece.
