Description

Pair of bronzes with brown patina - Auguste Louis Lalouette (1826-1883), French sculptor. Rare pair of bronzes with an early brown patina, signed Auguste Louis Lalouette, depicting as a pendant - The Victor and the Vanquished, circa 1870. The Cockfight. Signature on base. These two sculptures represent richly dressed duelists in the fashion of the 14th century, facing each other in a challenging pose, their gaze intense and expressive, each holding a rooster, a symbol of rivalry and bravery. The poses are elegant and full of dramatic tension, subtly conveying the spirit of the duel. The figures wear exquisitely refined costumes: breeches revealing bare legs, finely crafted shirts, capes, feathered hats, and earrings. The meticulous treatment of the fabrics, accessories, and faces testifies to the artist's
