### Description

Monumental Brass Torchiera Floor Lamp, in the Stilnovo Style Italian work, circa 1965-1975 A refined and architecturally balanced brass torchiera floor lamp composed of a slender column rising from a stepped circular base and culminating in a wide fluted conical uplighter shade. The finely ribbed shade creates a subtle play of reflected light, enhancing the warmth of the brass surface. The proportions (H 170 cm) are particularly harmonious, giving the piece a sculptural presence while maintaining visual lightness. The restrained design and quality of execution place this lamp within the aesthetic vocabulary of high-end Italian productions of the late 1960s, in the spirit of luxury modernism. Original patina. Height: 170 cm Shade diameter: 46,5 cm Founded. in Milan in 1946 by Bruno Gatta, Stilnovo is one of the brands the most emblematic of post-war design. She embodies the "Milanese Modernism". His creations are recognized by the use brass, tubular steel, blown glass and reflectors at. primary colors (red, yellow, blue) or black/white. Cult pieces: the lamp 626 (Gae Aulenti), the 8070 chandelier (in the shape of sputnik/star), the articulated arm streetlights and the appliques "diabolo". After a period of stop, the brand was bought by the group Linea Light, which reissues now the classics from the 50s to the 70s in LED version, while maintaining the original aesthetic.
