### Description

Le Tallec porcelain box, Paris. Cylindrical porcelain box with a golden yellow ground, decorated with black motifs representing floral garlands and ribbons. The central decoration depicts an assemblage of musical instruments surrounded by vegetal ornaments. The lid is highlighted with a decorative frieze featuring a small floral motif in relief on the front. Signed Le Tallec. The Camille Le Tallec factory (1906-1991) was a Parisian firm specializing in the decoration of high-end porcelain in the 20th century. Founded in 1930, it distinguished itself through its hand-painted decorations, often inspired by the 18th century (Sèvres or Louis XV style). It did not manufacture the porcelain itself but decorated pieces from major French manufacturers. Its production was renowned for
