Crafted from solid mahogany, figured mahogany veneer, stained sycamore, ebony, and boxwood, it combines functionality with aesthetic appeal.

The removable top features two sides: one adorned with two marquetry game boards--one for Checkers and one for Chess--while the other, serving as a desk, is covered in lime-green leather embellished with gilded Louis XVI tooling.

When the top is removed, a Backgammon board
