Engraving by Pieter van der Aa (Leiden, 1659-1733), one of the great Dutch publishers and booksellers of the late 17th and early 18th centuries. Beautiful panoramic view of Saint-Malo depicted from the opposite bank, probably the Saint-Servan side. The city appears powerfully encircled by ramparts, punctuated by round towers and dominated by the cathedral's bell tower, asserting its role as a strategic stronghold. The port, the true heart of the composition, is bustling with merchant ships and three-masted sailing vessels maneuvering in the harbor, while a small fishing boat occupies the foreground.
