This charming painting, entitled "Young Woman and the Cat," was painted by Henri Laville and bears the artist's signature in the upper right corner. Henri Laville was born on February 7, 1916, in Bordeaux and died on December 27, 1995, at the age of 79. Deeply attached to his city, he entered the Bordeaux School of Fine Arts and was a laureate of the Academy of Sciences, Letters, and Arts of that same city. He was also a student at the Paris School of Fine Arts, having received a scholarship. A resident at the Casa Velázquez in Madrid, he was awarded a prize. He also received

the Vermeil Medal from the City of Paris.

Throughout his career, he was praised by numerous prominent figures who owned some of his works.
