This charming painting, titled "Young Girl and Her Dog" (inscription on the back), was painted by Henri Laville, a highly renowned painter in the 1950s and 60s. This oil on canvas is sold unframed and bears the artist's signature. Two other paintings by the same artist are for sale in our gallery (see last photo). Henri Laville was born on February 7, 1916, in Bordeaux and died on December 27, 1995, at the age of 79. Deeply attached to his city, he entered the Bordeaux School of Fine Arts and was a laureate of the Academy of Sciences, Letters, and Arts of that same city. He was also a student at the Paris School of Fine Arts, having received a scholarship. A resident at the Casa Velázquez in Madrid, he was awarded a prize. He also received
