Christine Nilsson (1843-1921) was a renowned Swedish soprano. In 1868, she created the role of Ophelia in Ambroise Thomas's opera "Hamlet," at the premiere at the Salle Le Peletier of the Paris Opera on March 9, 1868. This role marked a turning point in operatic history and helped popularize the romantic and melodramatic image of Ophelia. Her performance was critically acclaimed and solidified her reputation as one of the greatest singers of her time. Charles Reutlinger (1816-1888) was a photographer specializing in portraits of Parisian personalities.
