Rosary pendant & metal pectoral crucifix & ebony INRI era Napoleon IIIA true gem of Christian craftsmanship from the mid-19th century, this crucifix is composed of a dark brown ebony wood body, surrounded by a silver metal with strong and diverse symbols. Jesus is crucified there, his head straight, crowned with a halo. Above his head, the inscription INRI meaning Jesus Nazarenus Rex Iudaeorum, that is to say «Jesus the Nazarene king of the Jews». Made to be worn at the level of the chest, hence its name of pectoral crucifix, it was popularized during the era of Napoleon III and was passed from family to wealthy Catholic family of the French Empire until today..
