The body and lid are decorated across their entire surface with a Chinese dragon executed in pronounced bas-relief. The interior is gilt (signs of wear). China, Shanghai, circa 1900. Maker's mark: Hung Chong & Co. Silver, at least 800/1000, French "swan" hallmark. Diameter: 9.5 cm Height: 7 cm Weight: 205 g Very good condition, without dents or deformations. * Prestigious institutions, such as the Huntington Museum of Art and the Australian National Maritime Museum, hold examples of Hung Chong silverware.
