### Description

A gourd-shaped stoneware pitcher with a green and beige glaze, signed "Lion" on the base. A potter in St. Amand en Puisaye, he interpreted and drew upon the influence of the Carrès School, creating art ceramics that combined Asian inspiration with local tradition, daring to use strong contrasts. He favored thick, rounded forms, which he covered with thick glazes. Eugène Lion's ceramic work perfectly represents the synthesis between the traditional object and the work of art.
